

Medical Sharp Disposal Guide

PRINCE WILLIAM COUNTY RESIDENTS

HOME USE ONLY

Used medical sharps such as **syringes** and lancets are accepted at the **Prince William County Landfill** when they come from personal household use.

How to prepare sharps

- Place used, recapped sharps in a rigid plastic container with a screw-on lid (for example, a detergent bottle).
- Close the lid tightly so the container cannot open during transport.
- Clearly label the container: **DO NOT RECYCLE.**

At the landfill

- Bring the sealed container to the **Prince William County Landfill.**
- Let staff know you have sharps for disposal.
- Use the designated sharps container as directed.
- Staff will direct you, but they cannot handle sharps for you.
